


# Flow Chart of Operations Directions for Provision of National Non-public Land for Passage of Isolated Land



Note 1: According to Article 3 of Operation Directions, the holders of the right to use the inaccessible land includes owner, the holder of superficies, the holder of an agricultural right, the holder of easement of the real estate, the holder of lien right, the lessee and holders of other rights to use the land, but excluding trustee and landscaping adopters of national inaccessible land.

Note 2: According to Article 4 of Operation Directions, if a transfer of a part of a piece of land or of the division of a piece of land prevents suitable access to the public road or if a piece of land has no suitable access to the public road and becomes unfit for ordinary use after the owner of many pieces of land has transferred some of the lands or simultaneously transferred all lands to others, the relevant implementation shall be carried out according to where Article 789 of the Civil Law Regulations applies (if, in consequence of a transfer of a part of a piece of land or of a partition of a piece of land, the land has no suitable access to the public road, and is not fit for ordinary use, the landowner in order to reach the public road, is only entitled to pass through the land owned by the transferee or the transferor or the other petitioners).

Note 3: According to Subparagraph 1 to 3, Paragraph 1, Article 6 of Operation Directions, if the selected land for passage has already been used or is shared land, it shall be handled according to the following provisions:

(1) There are other holders of the right to use the land: Unless the national land is used by others for access, managed by trustees, or used by adopters for landscaping, the applicant should obtain written consent of the owner with the right to use the land to apply for passage.

(2) Applicant's occupation: The applicant shall remove any objects on the land unrelated to passage.

(3) Occupation by others: If the land is in an area indigenous people have applied for as an aboriginal reservation, the applicant shall obtain the occupier's written consent to apply for passage. As for the remaining land, the applicant shall make a commitment to remove any obstacles by signing an affidavit.

Note 4: The change of registration of the national non-public land should be 'reserved', subcategory should be 'agreed for usage'. However, land that is provided again for passing, the area of which involves other users, occupants, trustee and landscaping adopters, the only thing required is to affix the code '1DB5' in the other item column. The name of the code is 'Providing passing or usage according to the Civil Code on neighboring relationship'.

Note 5: According to Subparagraph 1 to 3, Paragraph 1, Article 6 of Operation Directions, if the selected land for passage has shared land not managed separately, when the administrative agency consents to the holder of the right to use the passage, the person shall be required to obtain the consent of other co-owners.
